

# SUGGESTED CLOTHING and SUPPLY LIST 2010-2011

## Clothes for everyday wear:

shorts	blouses	light jacket	underwear
jeans	skirts	swimsuit	socks
slacks	dresses	sleepwear	walking/running shoes
shirts	rainwear	sandals

## Dress attire (including dress shoes) for dress dinners and other special occasions:
